**VOTERS MEETING UPDATE**: On Monday, June 21, the Voters Assembly agreed to contract with Bybee Organ Works for the purchase of a new digital organ. Fund raising to date has raised most of the purchase price of the organ. Immanuel needs to raise \$23,000 for the price of the organ plus approximately \$15,000 for construction of speaker cabinets and wiring. No budget funds will be used to pay for the organ. Delivery is expected in time for Advent. Pledges to make up the balance of these costs are needed.
